Introductions  
Group effort: read 12 Traditions & read 12 Concepts  
Roll call  
Quorum met -- 20 present/ 13 quorum

**Reports:**

**Secretary** – Susan S. read secretary's report. Harlan B made correction that will be reflected in Teri and Harlan will give this in their reports, \$9188.02 was starting balance as of last area. Elizabeth O made motion to accept, Carl B 2<sup>nd</sup>. Passed unanimous.

**Treasurer** – Teri F. read report (see attached). \$7484.97 beginning balance. Paid out \$2776.36. Revenue \$ 9327.42. ending balance \$14,036.03. Budget expenses \$1784 (see attached report). Available balance \$6402.03 \$118.29 suggested donation to be divided between Region and WSO. Literature beginning balance corrected to \$9188.02, sold \$2271.36, purchased \$2187.48 for ending balance of \$9104.14. Jennifer C brought up question about H&I budget last month, Jimmy E said it was \$247.91. Teri pointed out he requested a \$20 check, which brought the total to \$267.91. George M made motion to accept, Carl B 2<sup>nd</sup>, passed, unanimous

**H&I** – Jimmy E. gave report (see attached). All subcommittee reports were good. Spent \$208.66 on literature. Canadian County Jail, applications have been submitted, contact Jennifer C. Oklahoma County Juvenile Detention center, applications have been submitted, not yet started. Contact Jimmy C. Lots of interest, he is staying in touch. Bill F asked if they were planning workshops. He is going to ask GSRs to push for having workshops at their groups.

**PR** – Jim G made report (see attached). Subcommittee met at 10, discussed Outreach and inactive groups in WASC, want to enable Outreach to help them get involved. Needs to create inventory list of what Stan turned over to him. Also creating list of Phonenumber volunteers, plans to start managing it himself. Perhaps someone can take over later. Bill and Mike working on recruiting and training volunteers to PR for publication relations panels to meet with different outside groups. Send volunteers to PR for panels. Harlan also has PR stuff in his garage, mainly Tiki torches. Robert is still the main contact for the Phonenumber. Meeting schedule missing Great News group had errors, list is changing around.

**Website:** Ricky O sent report (attached). Requests that we e-mail him updates and flyers for meeting list, events page. Links to minutes has been fixed. Elizabeth O brought up that Ricky needs to use the WASC e-mail.

**Activities** : Carl B. gave report (see attached). Bill E reported for NWC. (see creport). Did fill most of positions except vice-chair, activities. Chair can appoint someone to fill position if needed. Theme is "Lifeboat in Sea of Recovery." Ricardo is looking into costs for shirts. Need art work. Private chat room has been set up on Facebook. Next meeting is 4-17-11 at NoNag at 3 pm. Looking for local speakers at 3 pm. Mardi Gras deposited \$413. Expenses \$358, earned \$45.

**Outreach** – Steve T. gave report (see report). Went to Seminole, need people there to support the meeting. Brian's Green Door in Anadarko, small meeting. He has 4-8 people that go with him. Suggests getting car load and visiting those groups to show what clear NA message is. He has a beginning speaker's list. He requested that GSRs take a copy, get names, bring back. Teri asked if part of Outreach they are going to established groups and asking if they want to go. He said it can be overwhelming to bring to many there.

**Literature** – Harlan B. gave report (see attached). Ending March 5 balance was incorrect. Step Working Guides and large-print It Works How and Why look similar. Five got mistakenly given to some group. Lost close to \$70. Formulas now fixed. Ending balance for January-Feb, \$9188.02. Sold 2271.36, purchased, 2187.48, ending balance for March area was \$9104.14. Turned \$2239.56 last WASC plus Outreach & HI \$318.37 for both. Tax was \$177.12. Put \$109.45 into general fund with the mark-up. 5% mark-up better for us. Second edition of Newsletter

is out and will be posted to website tonight. Committee still asking for input for newsletter, deadline for next edition is June 1, would like input on growing and fascinating topic: anonymity and social media. Also would like thoughts on United States Fellowship Assembly. Quarterly taxes of \$472.29 due. Newsletter cost \$74.57, Harlan donating the amount over \$70. Elizabeth O made motion to accept report, seconded by Carl B, passed, unanimous

R.C.M – Elizabeth O. had no report. Elizabeth brought extra insurance forms.

Coffee – Carl B. gave report (see attached). Starting balance \$51.25, \$5.00 donation, spent \$19.10 on supplies, ending balance of \$37.15

Break at 2:50, reconvened at 3:00 pm with Serenity Prayer.

#### Old Business:

Clinton meeting – taking it off the list? Tabled in March. Bill F read from By-Laws, Purposes and Responsibilities. Talked about history of another group. Tried for two years to help the group get in line with Traditions. WASC PR is responsible for meeting list to send people to meetings with clear NA group. They wrote letter to judge letting them said that this has been going on for two years, woman works for courts, Rob and David went down there to talk with them but same problems still exist. Jim G stated he would be willing to write letter to judge if we decide that is what needs to take place. Bill F discussed what we need to do. Elizabeth O clarified that woman is acting as surveillance. This has gone on for awhile. Elizabeth said we need to consider protecting NA as a whole. Teri F has worked with court system in rural areas. Courts have hard time understanding surveillance and compliance is not a job. The only way we can get around that. Bill suggested if we could send two PR subcommittee to visit with judge in effort to salvage the group. Gordon shared past experience. George M said he and sponsee in El Reno who would like to go. Harlan B stated he is willing to help.

Steve T made a motion to take a group to go talk with the woman reporting to judge, Mike made friendly amendment to talk to judge and entire drug court team. Restated motion as amended is to take a group to go talk with the judge and drug court team. Tom 2<sup>nd</sup>. Gordon asked if we had the DVD Just for Today to educate them. Harlan said George thinks he has a copy of it. Passed, unanimous.

#### New Business:

Jim G made motion to move July 2WASC to July 9 due to holiday weekend, Todd 2<sup>nd</sup>. Passed, unanimous

Bill E made motion to form a Hotel Liaison position for Norman Winter. This is also last year of contract with Embassy. Need someone to negotiate with other hotels. Carl B asked if this should not be up to NWC Committee itself? George asked if we cannot have it there. Bill said we are just looking for better options. Bill F gave a vote of confidence to committee and chair. Susan brought up the Steve appointed Susan S, Harlan B, Jennifer, Ricardo C. They will report back to WASC. The committee will select chair.

Jim G: Can we create an exclusive Chat Room and WebCast for WASC to GSRs in SW Oklahoma? There was discussion. Bill F said he could see this as a way to benefit outlying groups. Jim will work on it.

Bill F: US Fellowship Assembly report. Attended in March in Wichita ([www.usassembly.org](http://www.usassembly.org)). Pointed out Motion 6 in 2002 CAR asked World to create new assembly of US Regions that would not be appropriate to bring to World. World responded this should not be discussed at the World Conference because it does not apply to NA. Other Forums and Zonal Assemblies were not created by World. They said we do have authority to create this assembly. Three proposals came out. One was to create a US Conference. This conference would bring back the subcommittees, have a board of trustees. It would be approved by group conference. If 5% of groups wanted it, they would create it. The next assembly will be in Tulsa October 28-30. Bill stated his opinion was that if we create an assembly, it could be a good thing. World is a lot of money. If they create a conference, it is a step backwards prior to reorganization. South Florida is the one where the Motion 6 in the CAR, and also where this idea came from. He asked them if this is an attempt to recreate their own literature? No answer. George asked if they were printing own literature and selling it – Bill F confirmed they were printing old literature. Harlan said he thinks it came because of Resolution A. Teri F said that they were misrepresenting, differing from other conferences because they are wanting to create own literature. Bill said that they were talking about something between regions and world. World said to create an assembly, not a conference.

Mike brought to our attention that SOGNA is concerned about the \$90 registration fee for world convention with no exceptions. He wants WASC to write letter, bring this to Region and get our voice to World. Bill F said he thought it would be more impressive to have letters from all members.

Jimmy E: Need to hold more H&I workshops – Attention GSRs – take it to your groups. In Eastern Area, they make it mandatory to attend workshop or sign a form on NA H&I. The purpose is to carry a clear message. Harlan clarified it is actually an orientation. Need to make sure panel leaders know that the people have been oriented.

## United States Fellowship Assembly Report

In March I attended the United States Fellowship Assembly held in Wichita KS. The following report is submitted based on my observations and participation at the Wichita Assembly. Any additional information can be found at [www.usfellowshipassembly.org](http://www.usfellowshipassembly.org).

Before I attended there was some misinformation concerning the United States Fellowship Assembly. One was that this assembly was an outside issue and could not be announced in NA meetings. The core members who are instrumental in creating the assembly were quick to point out that in keeping with the spirit of our 2nd and 9th Traditions, and to ensure that we stay focused on the objectives for that gathering, they ask all participants to tailor their individual behavior to the principles put forward in our 12 Steps and 12 Traditions.

2. For our group purpose there is but one ultimate authority— a loving God as He may express Himself in our group conscience. Our leaders are but trusted servants; they do not govern.

9. NA, as such, ought never be organized, but we may create service boards or committees directly responsible to those they serve.

In addition the core group pointed out Motion 6 in the 2002 C.A.R. (Conference Agenda Report), which was submitted by the South Florida Region. Basically Motion 6 asked NA World Services to help create a new Assembly of United States Regions to address local issues that would not be appropriate at the World Conference.

World's recommendation on Motion 6 was: **"Rather than even entering into the discussion of this issue and its history, our belief is this should not be a responsibility of World Services or a decision of the WSC. The purpose the World Service Conference is clearly stated: "Conference deliberations serve the needs of a diverse membership of different languages and cultures and address the challenge on how to provide effective services to NA groups around the world. The conference works for the good of all NA, taking into account both present and future needs."**

**Other forums are zonal assemblies, none of which was created by WSC. If the US Regions wish this to happen, they should make decision and decide how best to achieve it. This motion refers to a US Assembly, while the rationale refers to Resolution A and participation at the conference. Our recommendation only addresses the motion and does not address what is contained in the rationale.**

When asked if we had the authority to create a US conference there answer was: "of course we did." They further stated: "The EDM (European Delegate Meeting), the CANA (Canada Assembly of Narcotics Anonymous), the APFNA (Asian Pacific Forum of Narcotics Anonymous) were not created by an act of or decision by the WSC. Neither should the creation of a United States Service Conference! In fact it is precisely what the World Board recommended we do in the 2002 in response to motion 6 to hold the first US Assembly."

There are three proposals that came out of the Wichita Assembly and one was to create the United States Service Conference. This conference would bring back the subcommittees, have a board of trustees, and use the old terms RSR (Regional Service Representative) and ASR (Area Service Representative). The creation of a US Service Conference would be approved by Group Conscience. The number of Groups needed to approve the creation of a conference was unclear.

After I returned home I did a little homework and discovered that the EDM, the CANA, and the APFNA did not have subcommittees, a board of trustees, or create their own literature. At the Wichita meeting there was discussion on not using the 12 Concepts or possibly rewriting the concepts. So whether we create a conference or an assembly is still up in the air. The next United States Fellowship Assembly will be held in Tulsa OK October 28<sup>th</sup> – 30<sup>th</sup> 2011. More shall be revealed.
